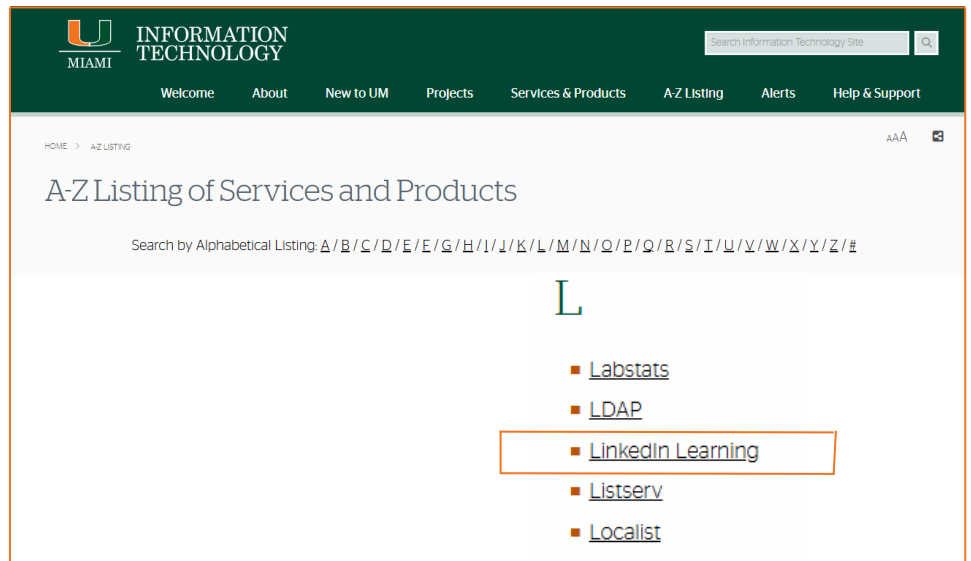
Activate Your LinkedIn Learning Seat

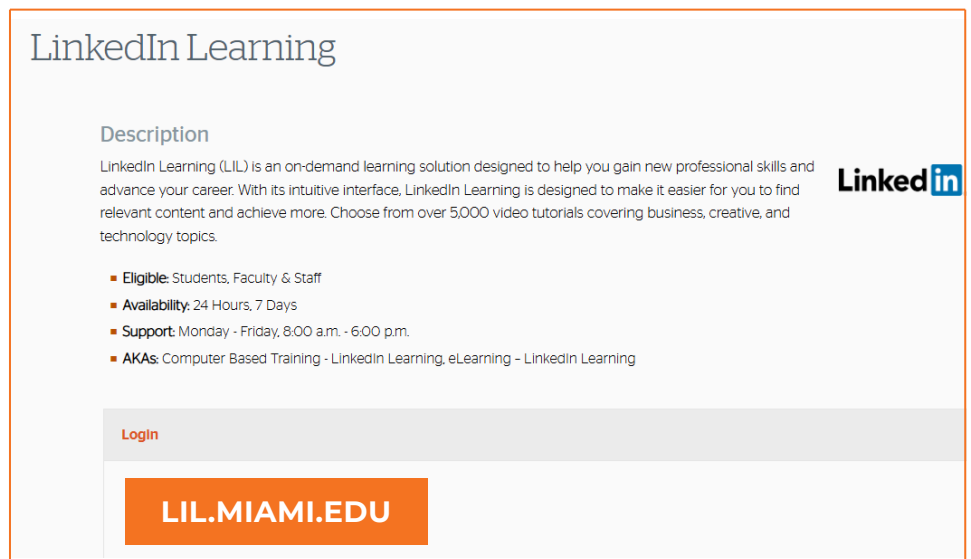

3. Select LinkedIn Learning

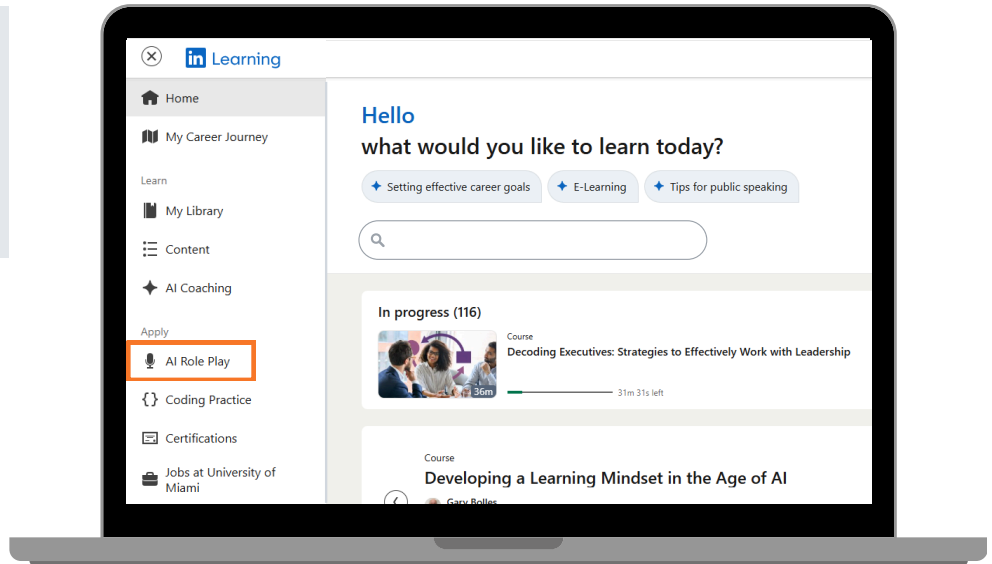

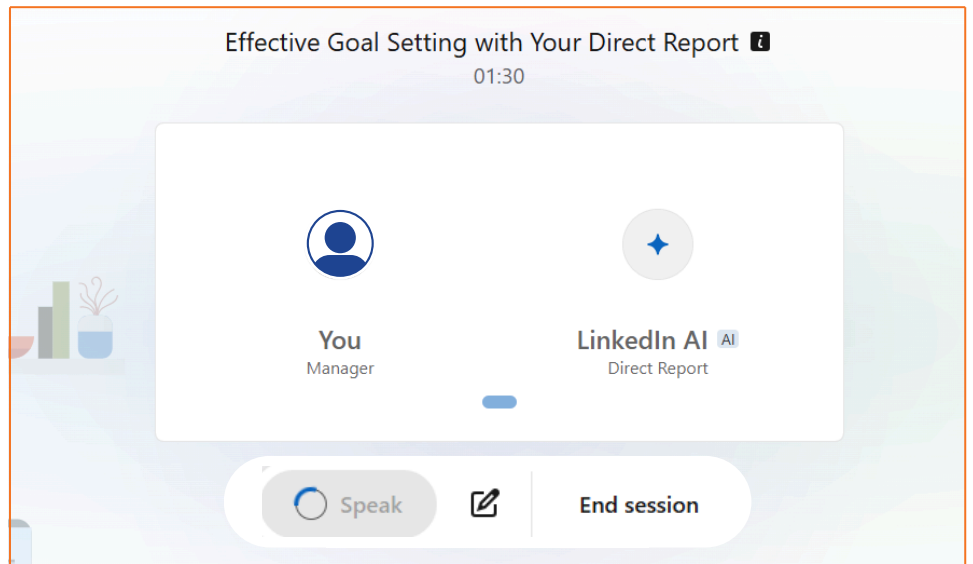

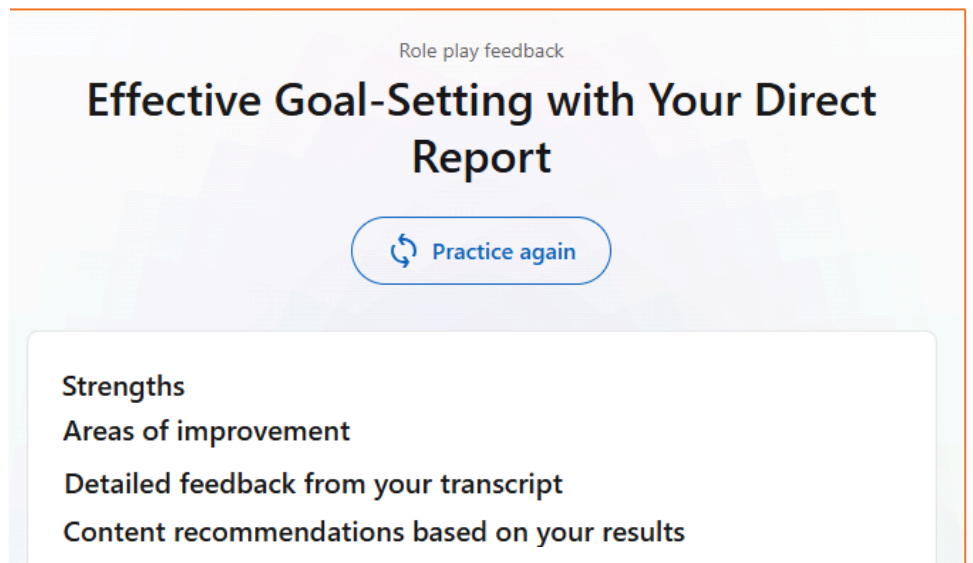
